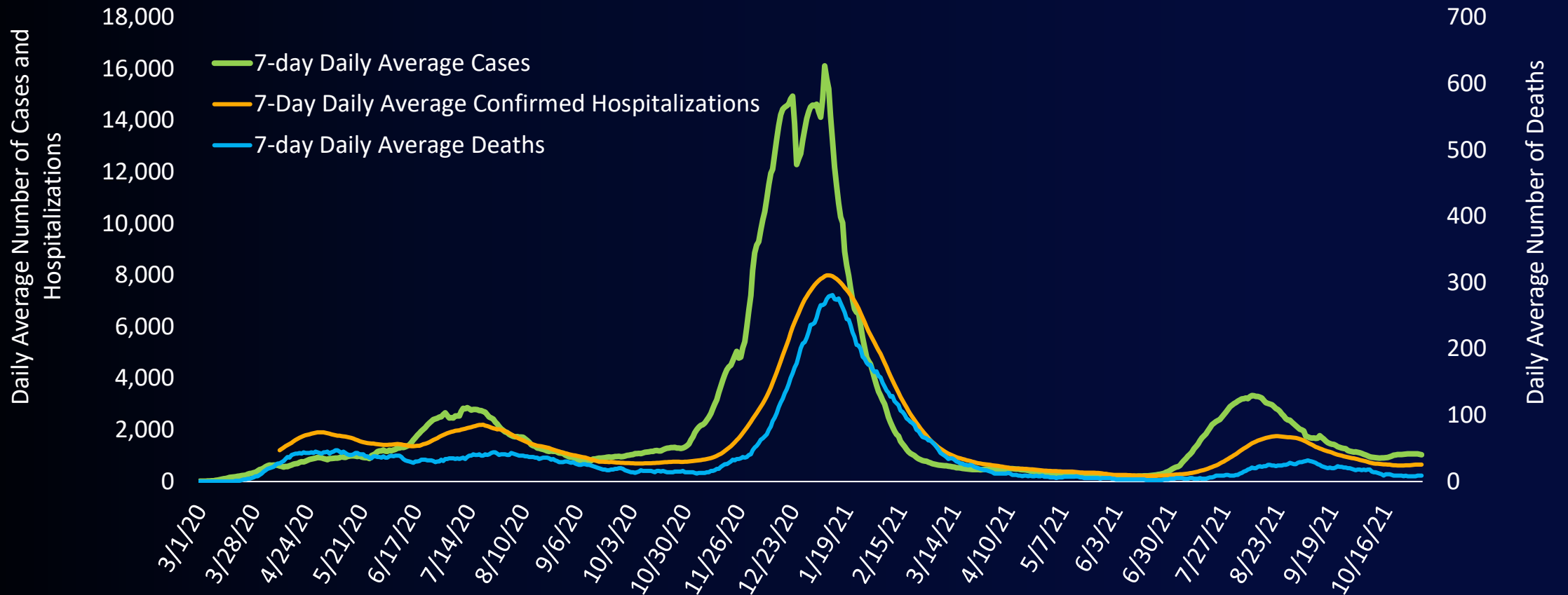

March 1st, 2020 – November 3rd, 2021

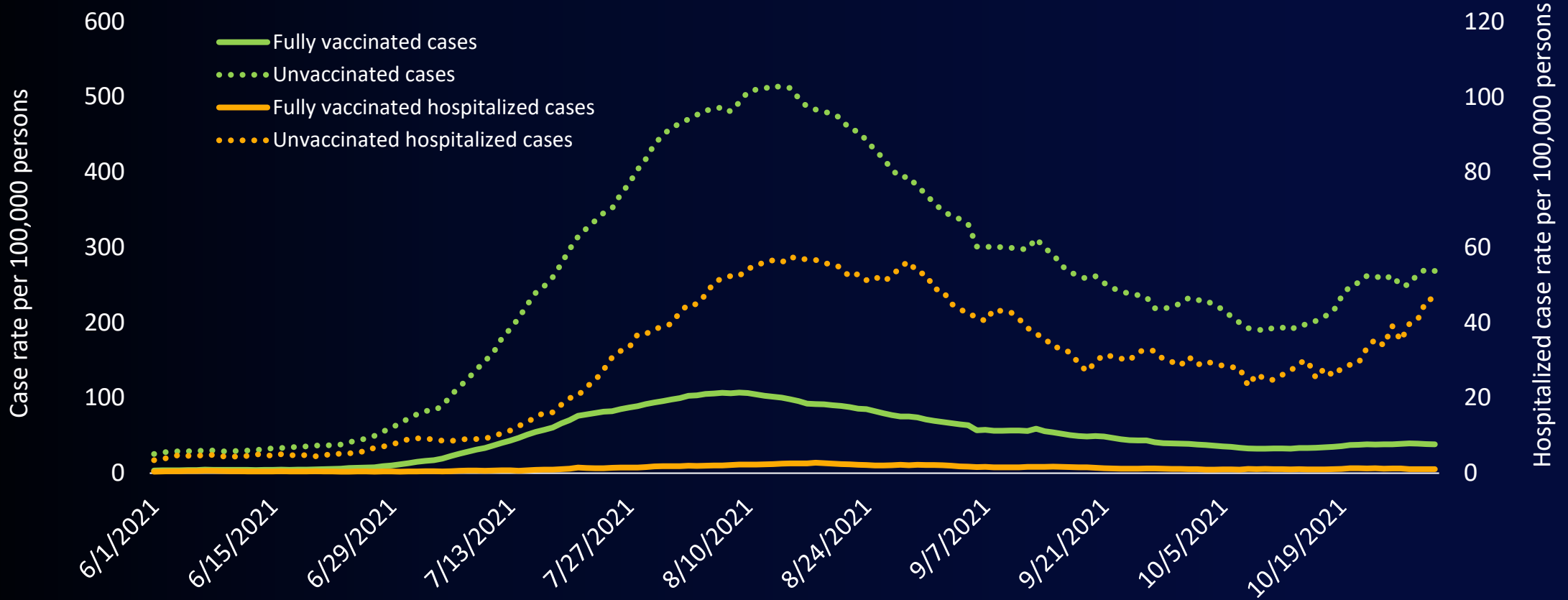

June 1st – October 30th, 2021



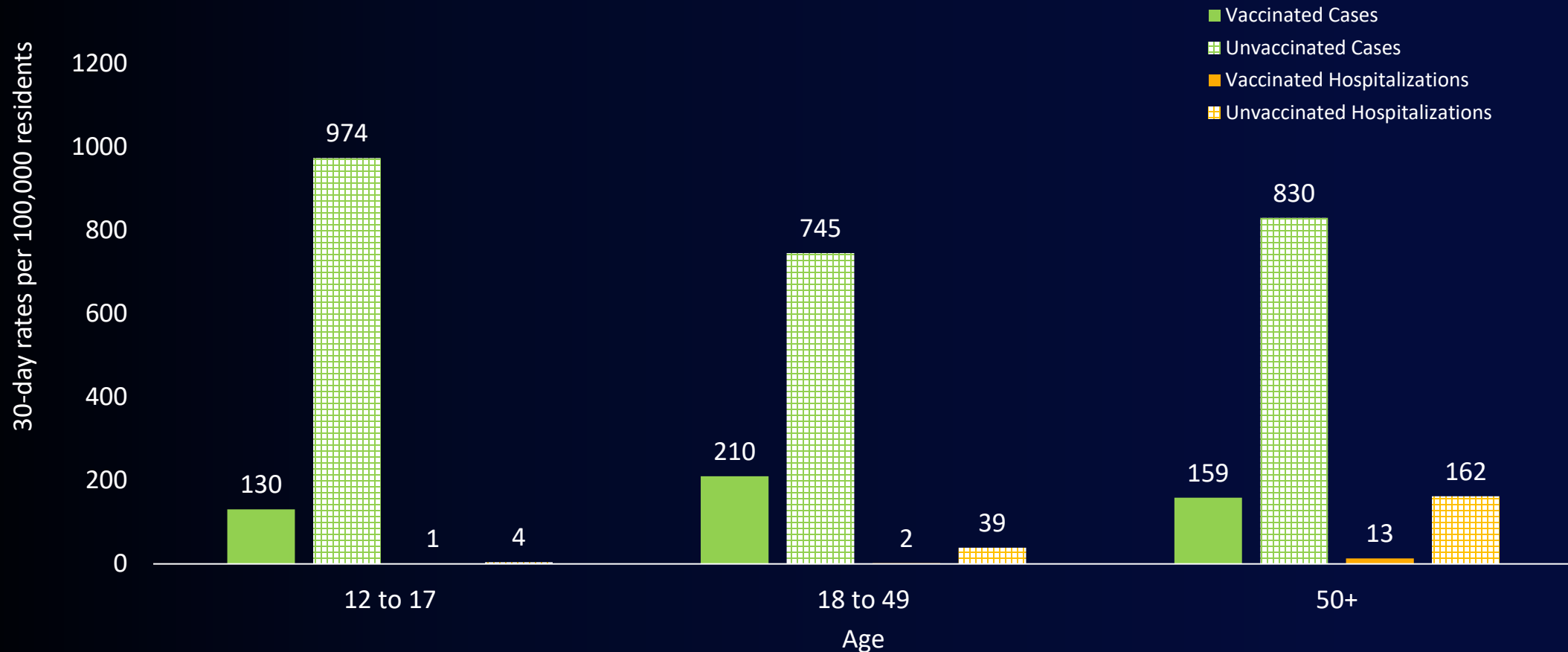

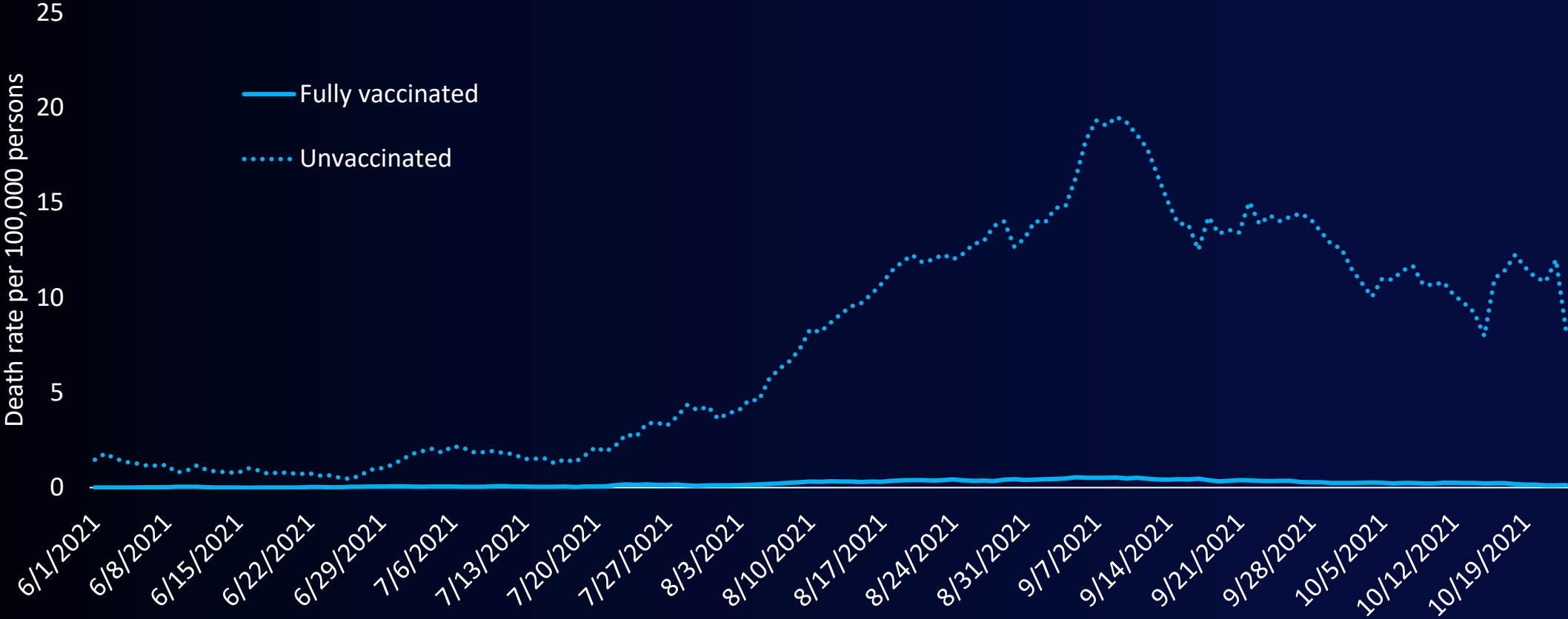

7-Day Cumulative Age-Adjusted Death Rates by Vaccination Status* July 1st—October 23rd, 2021



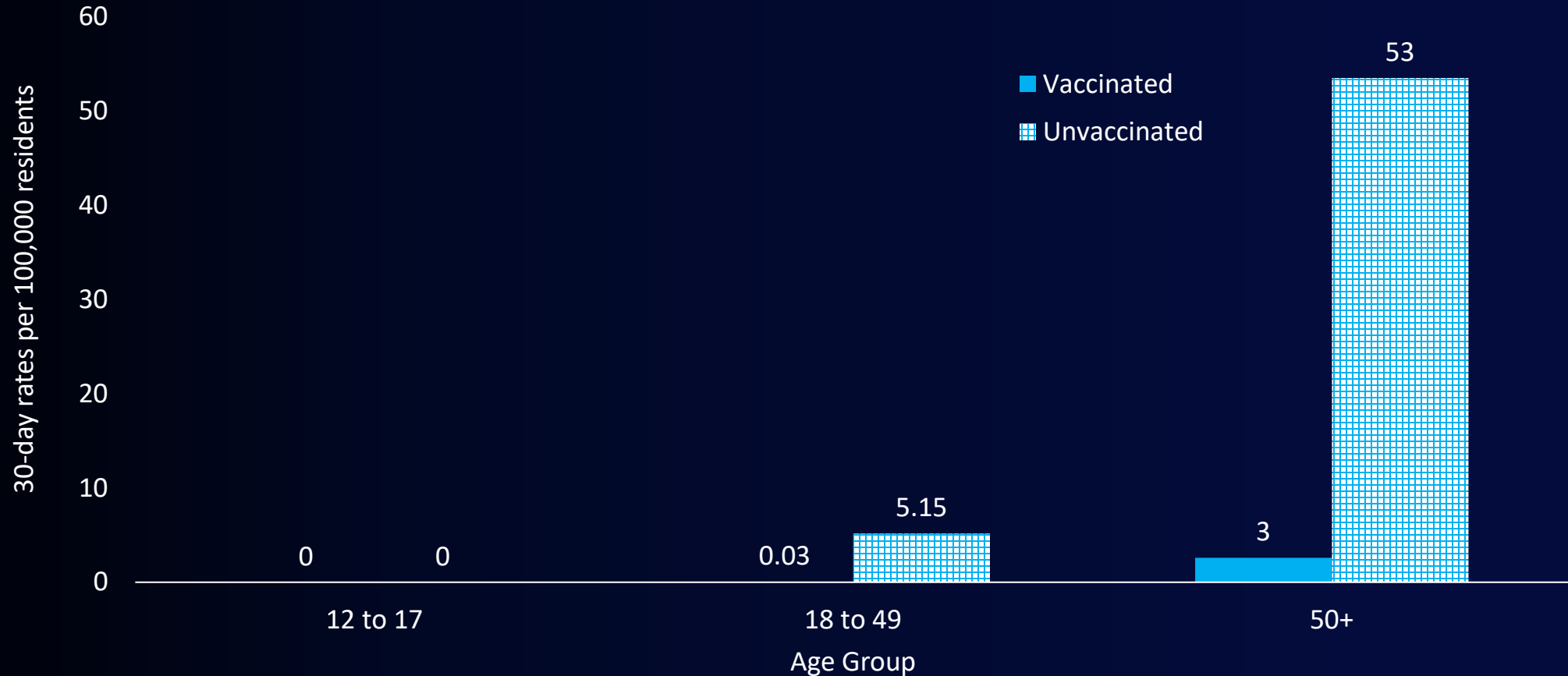

30-Day Cumulative Age-Adjusted Death Rates by Vaccination Status and Age Group, September 29 – October 29, 2021

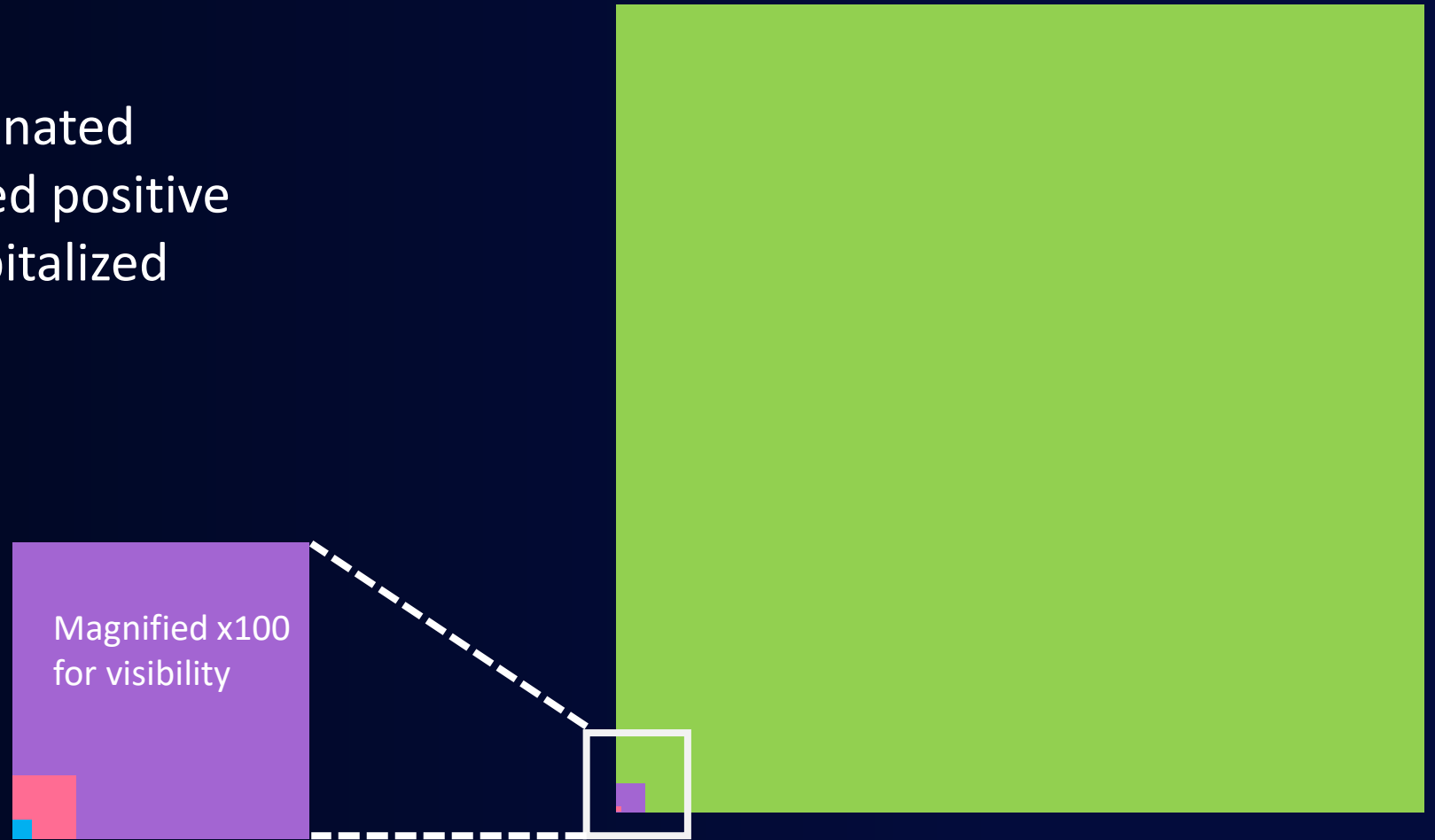

Covid Among Fully Vaccinated People in LAC as of November 9, 2021

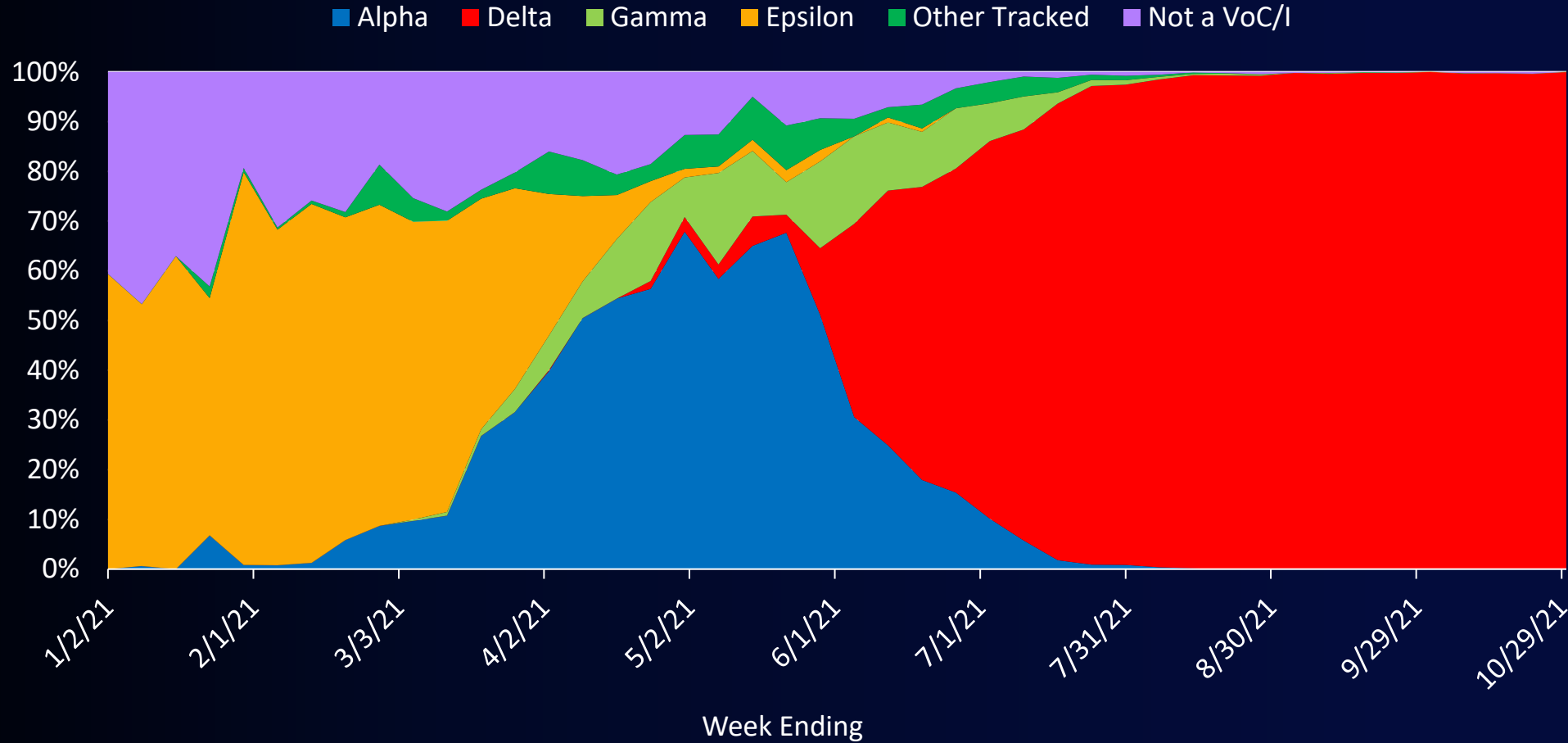
- 5,938,534 fully vaccinated

Most Commonly Identified Variants Among LAC Residents as a Percentage of Sequences Reported to Public Health

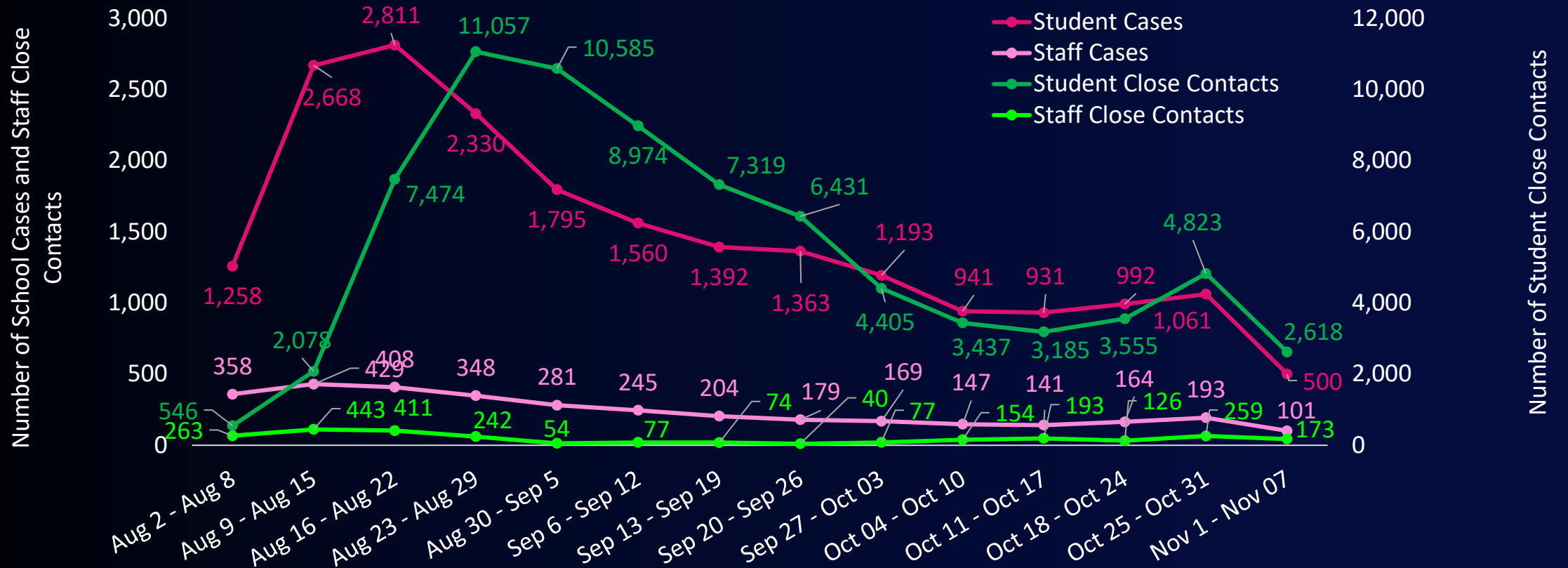

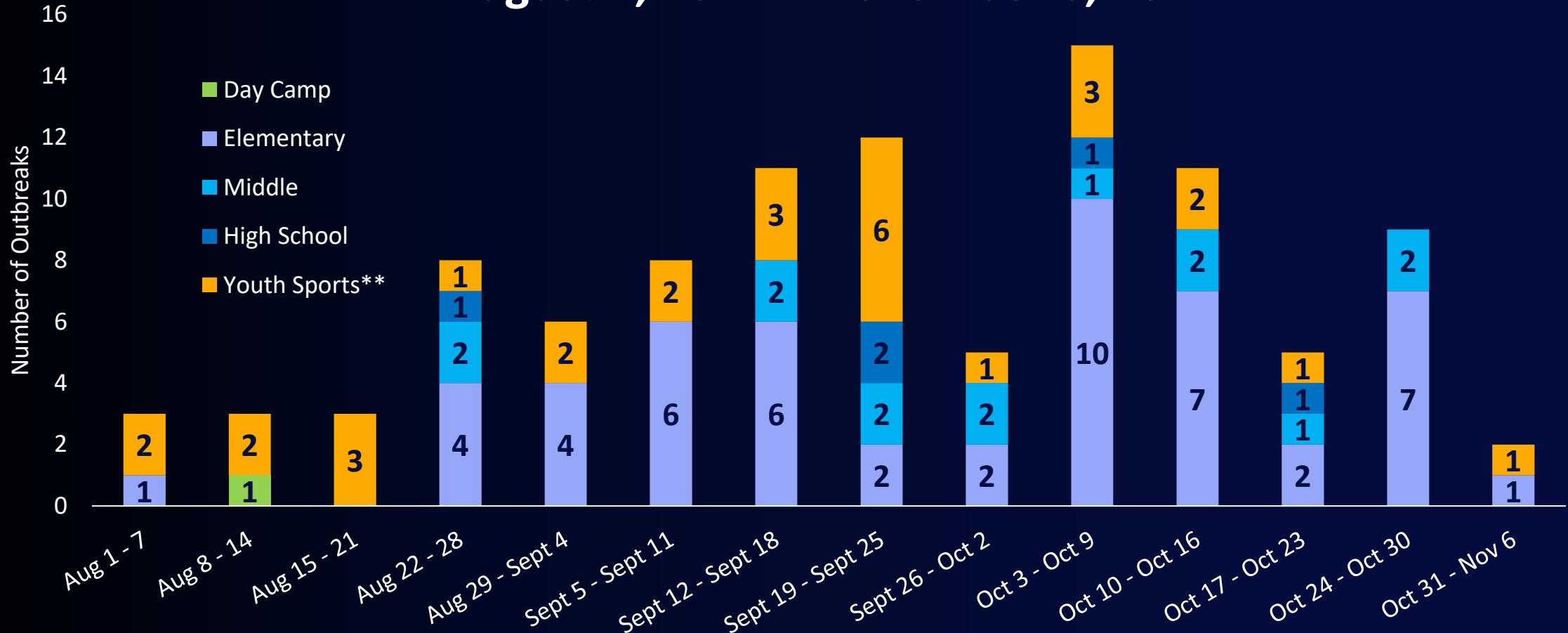

* Outbreaks are reported by the date the outbreak investigation was opened. Outbreaks may still be open and under investigation

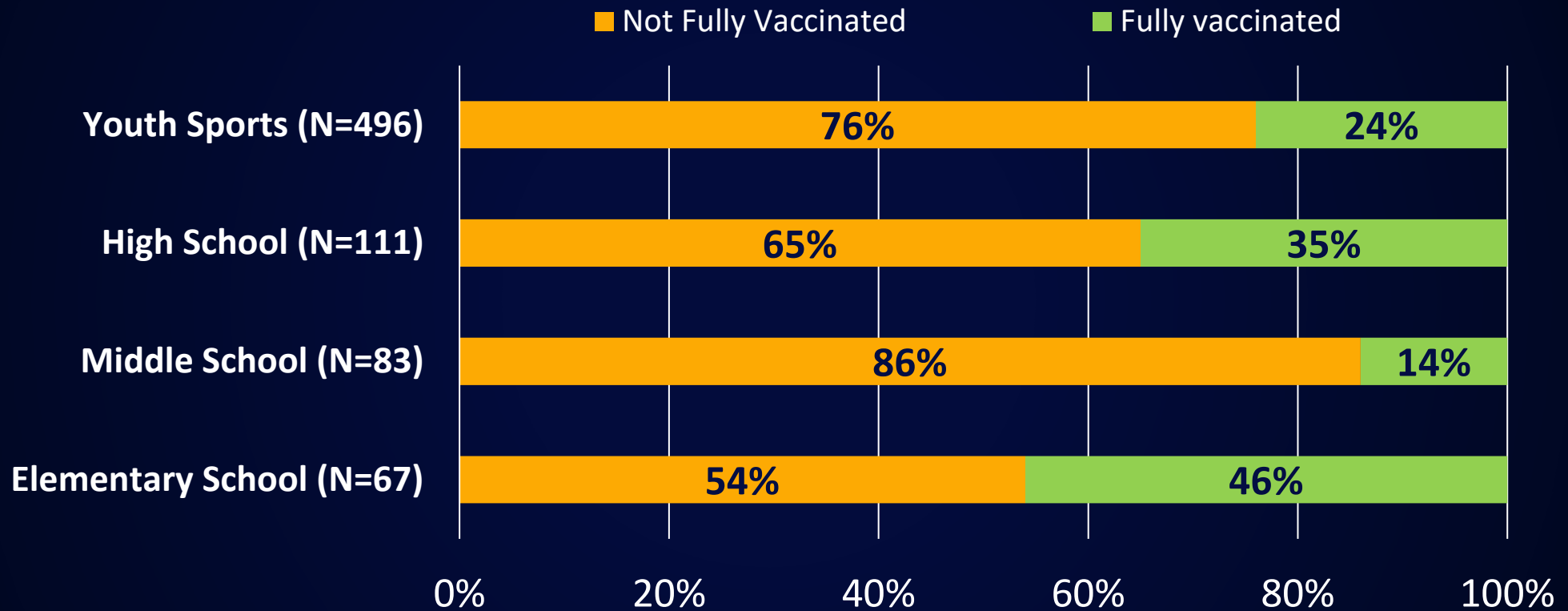

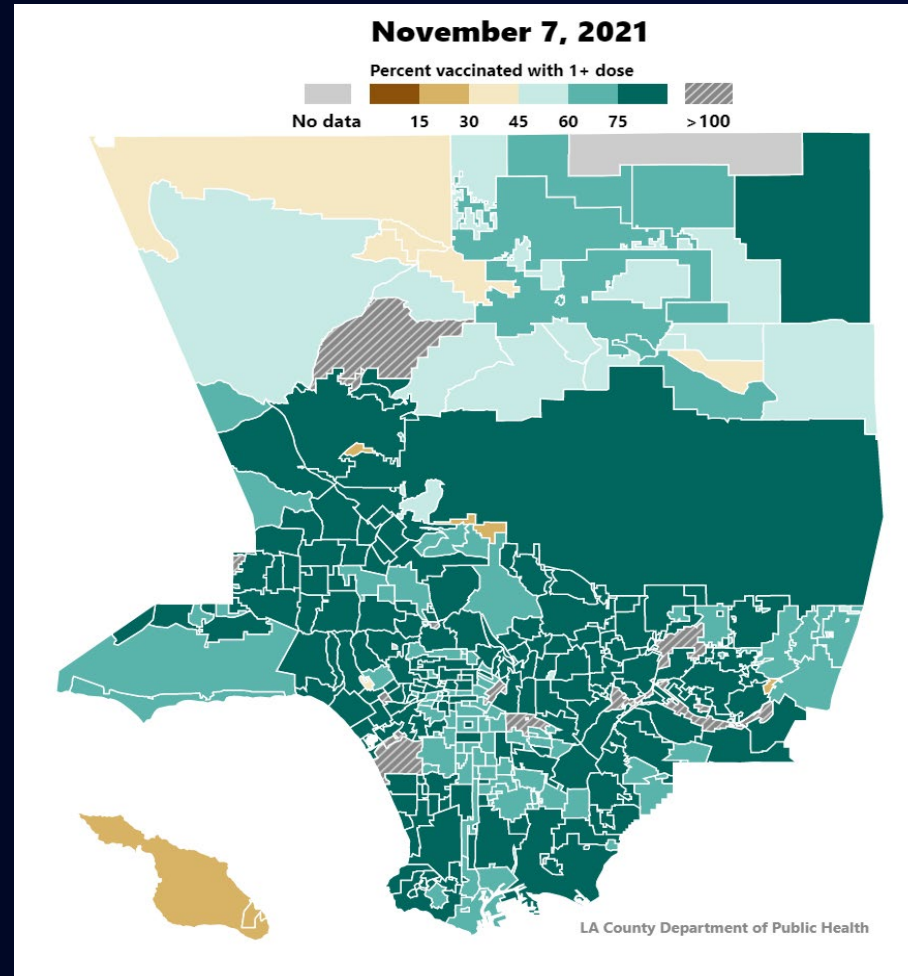

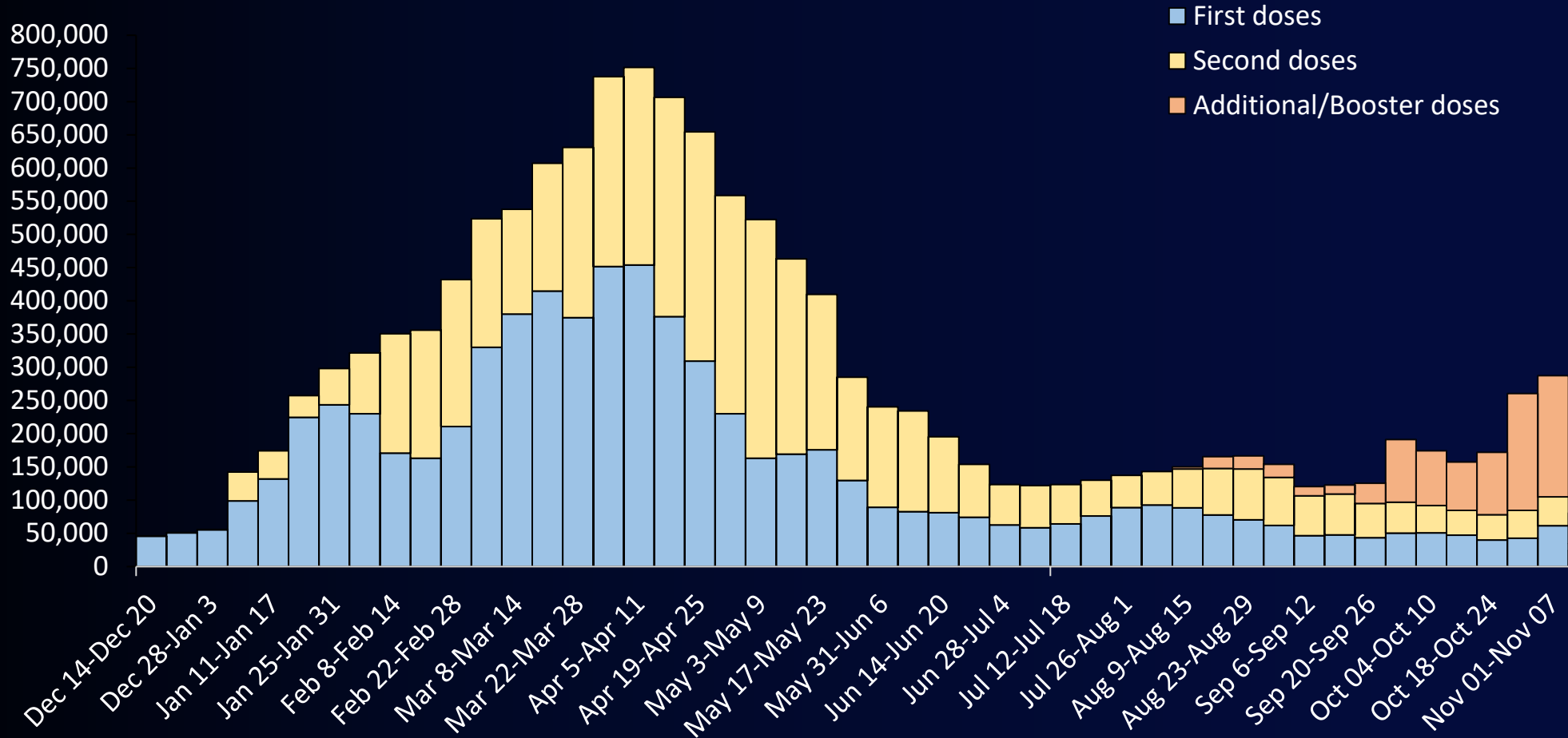
LAC Residents 12+ with ≥ 1 Dose Vaccine

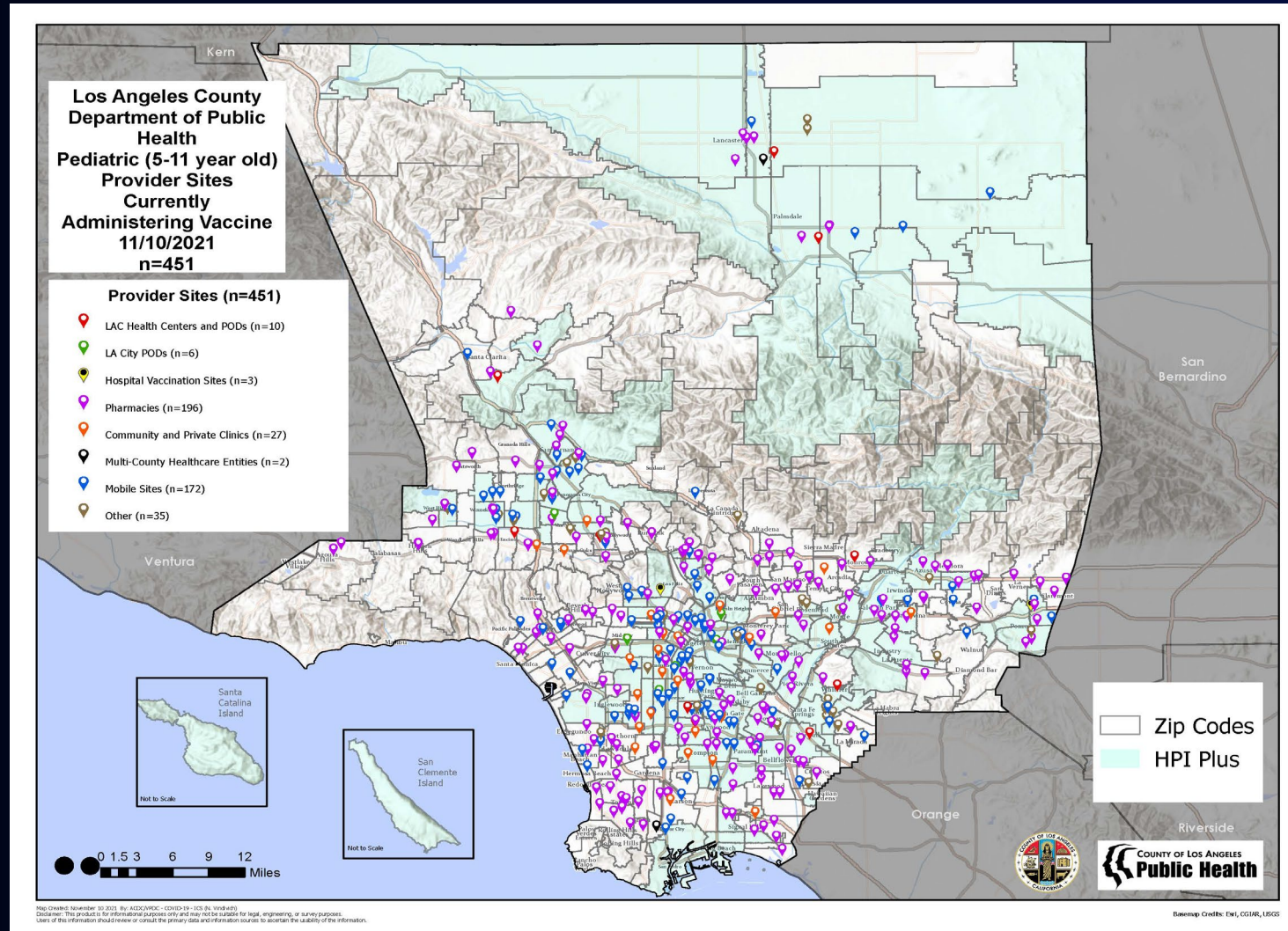

Fixed and Mobile Vaccination Sites Providing Pediatric Doses

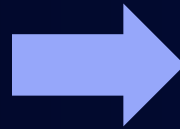

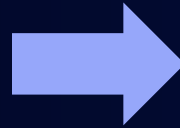
Preventing the Spread and Health Impacts of COVID-19

Vaccination available and free for everyone 5 years old and up



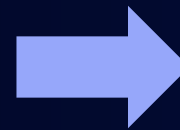
More people are protected from getting and spreading Covid—19

Boosters available for many adults



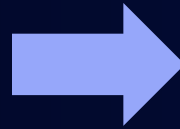
More durable protection for everyone

Two new oral antiviral treatment candidates (+ two existing IV therapies)



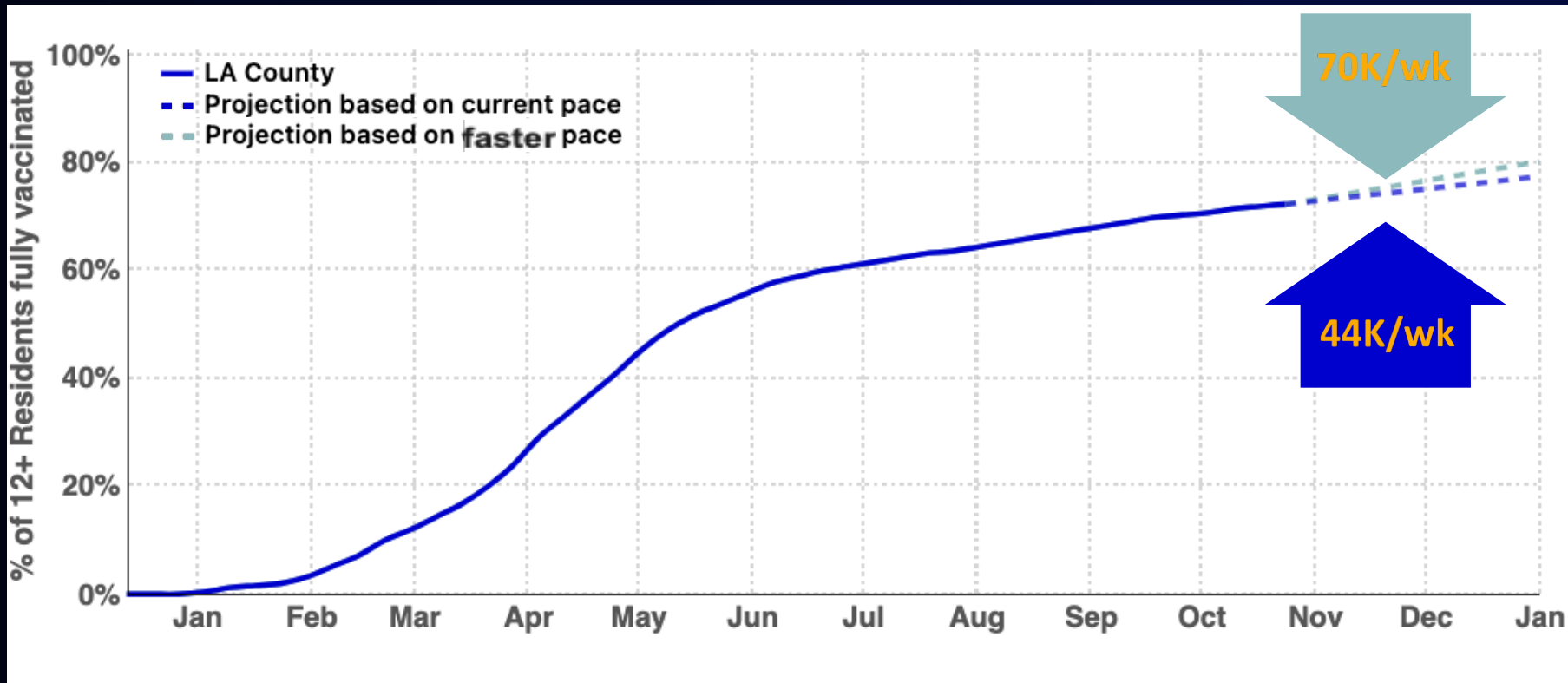
More premature deaths can be prevented in people who get sick

Preparing for Winter

What we can do to reduce transmission as the weather cools:

- Get everyone 5+ in your family and social circle vaccinated
- Get a booster dose if you're 18+ and eligible
- Get tested before gathering with high-risk people (elderly, immunocompromised, unvaccinated)
- Mask up in indoors and in crowded places
- Stay home if you're sick
